Sekar Jagat

Inspired by the blooming of fragrant flowers, 'Sekar' translates as fragrant flowers and 'Jagat' as the world. This graceful dance embodies the serenity of the universe, as the slow blossoming of fragrant flowers perfumes the atmosphere.

Baris Tunggal

Baris Tunggal, a Single Warrior Dance, embodies the strength, vigilance, and nobility of a warrior, with each step symbolizing courage. It is a powerful fusion of battlefield rituals, brought to life through deep expressions and captivating movements.

Legong & Condong

A timeless dance born from the royal courts, with delicate and gentle rhythms conjuring royalties from within and far-off lands in a set of vibrant stories through movement.

Jauk Manis

A charismatic performance portrays a fierce king with bold and dynamic moves, depicting the balance of power and compassion. This story transcends the vanity of the striking golden mask, revealing a passionate protector.

Joged Dance

A style of dance from the Island of Bali derived from the traditional Gandrung dance. The term joged or joget is also a common word for dance in Indonesia. The dance is typically accompanied by a gamelan ensemble of bamboo instruments.

Pendet

A ceremonial dance to welcome the gods and spirits with floral offerings, with grace and poise.

Topeng Dalem

Portraying a benevolent and noble king of the Golden Age of the Balinese Kingdom, with a mix of dances to express dignity and spiritual maturity.

Kupu – Kupu Tarum

A modern, elegant Balinese dance depicting butterflies, Kupu-Kupu, meaning butterfly, and Tarum; a flower synonymous with natural beauty. The dance portrays a graceful transformation from chrysalis to emerging as a spectacular butterfly.

Topeng Tua

A traditional mask dance, 'tua' translates as 'old', portraying an old man characterized by wisdom, humor and full of life experiences.

Panyembrama

Comes from the word sambrama, means welcome, this dance is performed when there are official events to welcome guests, and is also often performed during ritual ceremonies. This dance is the foundational dance and the very first one taught to children who are beginning to learn Balinese dance.

Topeng Keras

Portraying a benevolent and noble king of the Golden Age of the Balinese Kingdom, with a mix of dances to express dignity and spiritual maturity.

Cendrawasih Dance

Inspired by the bird of paradise, which is known as burung Cendrawasih in Indonesian and as manuk dewata ("the Bird of the Gods") in Balinese

Topeng Monyer

Delight in the playful charm of Topeng Monyer, a comedic character in Balinese mask dance. Revel in the humor and entertainment brought to life through its exaggerated movements.

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
